

Habitats of animals

Step	Description	What the children do
1	<p>The teacher hands out a worksheet (Attachement).</p> <p>The children classify and write. In the second phase, they also use their imagination and individual knowledge to add other animals. In this case, they can consult a dictionary for the spelling, or they should be permitted to write the word in German.</p>	
2	<p>If the teacher considers it appropriate or wants to expand on their class language awareness, she can ask the class to find out if there are words which are spelt identically in English and German (not considering the capitalized initial letter in German). She can then point out that a few words have some similar or identical sounds, for example the /f/ sound and the /ks/ sound in the “fox”.</p>	<p>The children may turn to spelling and pronunciation in a comparative way. Language awareness and higher order thinking skills are trained, but this should be a by-product only.</p>
